***Rubus French Cuvee Brut, NV
Burgundy, France***

Elegant pale yellow color with fine bubbles. Floral and fruity on the nose, with aromas of fresh butter and cake. On the palate, the wine is crisp and harmonious - a delightful sparkling wine.



***Putterstock Reid Reipersberg Gruner
Veltliner 2019
Wolfsgraben, Austria***

From one of the older Grüner Vineyards in the Weinviertel, the Reipersberg has “Urgestein” and shows wonderful complexity, minerality, fresh intense exotic scent, spic and elegance.



Alain de la Treille Rose 2019 Saint-Romain-Sur-Cher, France

40% Gamay, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon and 20% Pinot Noir

This dry Rosé is very aromatic with tons of fresh strawberry and watermelon type of flavors. The fruitiness is very elegant and the finish is nice and balanced.

Domaine Manoir du Carra Estate Beaujolais 2018 Burgundy, France

Lurid ruby-red. Bright, sharply defined red fruit and floral scents are sharpened by a mineral nuance that builds with aeration. Shows very good clarity and bite on the palate, offering subtly sweet raspberry and cherry flavors that deepen on the back half. Fine-grained tannins shape the finish, which lingers with very good, spicy tenacity.



Leo Hillinger "Eveline" Pinot Noir 2017 Burgenland, Austria

This superb value is elegant and pretty, which is why he named it after his wife, Eveline. Scents of rose petals with cranberry and red cherry notes develop as the wine opens in the glass. Hints of violet and vanilla make its dominant red fruit aromas more interesting. The finish is very long and quite smooth: no edges, just pure pleasure.



Arrowood Proprietary Red 2013 Sonoma, CA
